Appraisal/Inquiry - Journey

2017

- ERO review suggests that we need to create a more robust appraisal system.
- Appraisal Connector implemented and teachers provided with PD
- Teachers use Appraisal Connector Feedback was unsure of how to use the site, teachers only using the reflections part of the site.

2018

- CoL create a new Inquiry Model
- Teachers still using appraisal connector Issues with appraisal connector...Teachers are only writing reflections or a record of PD,, no evidence inquiry, Staff unsure of how to conduct an inquiry, AC very tricky to use - put teachers off using. NO collaboration happening
- Discussions around the development of a new system
- Develop Google Sites for each teacher to Organise appraisal documentation. Teachers own the site and is owned by the teachers not the school


